


Minutes from the 4-26-2016

Legislative and Ordinance Committee meeting

In attendance: Councilors Figy and Onyski

Meeting called to order at 6PM in Room 315, City Hall

Agenda:

- 1) 3-3-16, from the Traffic Commission, to amend Chapter 17-119 to allow one hour parking on the northerly side of School Street to a point approximately 106 feet from the corner of Washington Street. 2- ) for this item to be forwarded to the full Council with a positive recommendation by a 2-0 vote.
- 2) 3-3-16, from the Traffic Commission, to add to Chapter 7-115, parking prohibited on the westerly side of Coleman Avenue from East Silver Street to a point 220 feet south on Coleman. Forward this item to the full Council with a 2-0 positive recommendation.
- 3) 4-7-16, From the Traffic Commission, Chapter 17-115, delete parking prohibited on Woodmont Street, by a 2-0 vote gave a positive recommendation to the full Council.
- 4) 4-7-16, From the Traffic Commission, Chapter 17-115, delete parking prohibited on Dartmouth Street by a 2-0 positive vote to send to the full Council.
- 5) 4-7-16, From the Traffic Commission, Chapter 17-121.1, delete 20 minute parking on Dartmouth Street, by a 2-0 positive vote to the full Council.
- 6) 4-7-16, A resolution from the City Council of the City of Westfield to authorize a funding agreement with the Westfield Redevelopment Authority that allows access to the funds to be allocated through the Stabilization account and a transfer from the short term interest account to advance the Elm Street Urban Renewal Project, by a 2-0 vote recommended positively to the full Council.
- 7) 4-7-16, to re-appropriate Water System Bonds#2410,#2238,#2342,and #2151 for a total of \$92,950.921 to re-purpose these bonds to fund water repair projects, by a 2-0 vote a positive recommendation was made to the full Council.
- 8) 5-1-14, a motion by Councilor Figy to amend Chapter 11 Article II relative to the Columbia Rail Trail, by a 2-0 vote, recommended this item remain in Committee and be refered to DPW, Parks and Rec, Legal and the Mayors Round Table.
- 9) 3-19-15, a motion by former Councilor Crean, to implement legislation that would allow the Westfield Police Department to enforce noncriminal disposition infractions for recreational and Marine patrols, by a 2-0 vote gave a positive recommendation to the full Council.
- 10) 2-4-16, A motion by Councilor Babinski for the Natural Resources Committee to amend Chapter 16-152, Public Shade Trees relative to the application and fine fees. Discussion resulted in an amendment passing 2-0 to eliminate the \$50 per inch trunk diameter fine. The amended oridnance was voted 2-0 to be forwarded to the full council with a positive recommendation.

- 11) 3-17-16, laying out and discontinuing a section of Princeton street as recommended by the Planning Board. These will allow for a clean title to be obtained by the Mosley Street School Property. A 2-0 vote was made to give a positive recommendation to the full Council.
- 12) 3-17-16, a resolution of the City Council of the City of Westfield to authorize an inter-municipal Agreement with the PVTA, by a 2-0 vote it was recommended to the full Council with a positive recommendation.
- 13) 4-7-16, a resolution of the City Council of the City of Westfield to authorize the City to purchase a 1/4 acre parcel of land (72-41) from Oak Realty Corporation for the sum of \$750.00 to acquire property for the Airport Industrial Park, by a 2-0 vote it was recommended to the full Council with a positive recommendation.
