This project includes the demolition of 3 outbuilding structures, replacement of an existing garage into addit ional living space, and renovation of the existing single family home. The structures are within the 100-Year Flo od Zone & Zone AE. These are areas that have a 1% probability of flooding each year & are considered to be at High Risk for flooding under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and have special restriction require ments. The current home itself is partially within the 200-foot riverfront zone. The portion of the home to be r enovated is entirely outside the 200-foot zone.
