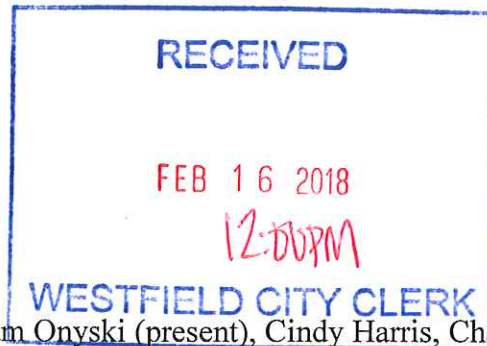


Personnel Action Committee
