

Prior to the vote, Councilor Flaherty questioned if there would be discussion on line items. President Onyski replied that discussion was held in the budget meetings. Councilor Flaherty informed the Council that he is opposed to the community TV budget, the School budget, pension fund and OPEB fund. President Onyski asked Councilor Flaherty for specific cuts. Councilor Sullivan informed the Council that he voted against the School budget in the budget meeting because he feels it is underfunded, but will support it tonight because the Council cannot add to the budget. Councilor Flaherty asked for a point of order. He asked if the \$57,000 in Personnel and the \$460,000 in Sewer and Wastewater were discussed and is this approving all the revenue projections and the health care fund. Councilor Beltrandi replied

that these items were discussed in the committee of the whole budget meetings. Councilor Flaherty informed the Council that he has talked to the Mayor relative to his concerns of the budget, but he will support the budget as submitted.


