COMMUNICATION REGARDING WESTFIELD TRANSFER STATION

The Westfield Health Department has announced that the Twiss Street Transfer Station is currently closed and will remain closed until Wednesday, July 1, 2020. This closure is as a result of construction currently being conducted at the Transfer Station as well as budgetary constraints facing the City.

Residents who purchased a Transfer Station entrance sticker for fiscal year 2020 (July 1-June 30) will be allowed to continue using that sticker through September 30, 2020. Those wishing to use the Transfer Station after July 1st, and who do not currently have an entrance sticker, will be allowed to purchase a temporary sticker for the cost of \$10.00 which will be good from July 1 through September 30, 2020.

To obtain a temporary entrance sticker, residents should mail a check or money order made payable to "City of Westfield" in the amount of \$10.00, along with proof of residency to:

Beginning in mid-September, fiscal year 2021 entrance stickers will be available at the reduced rate of \$20.00 and will be effective from October 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

Effective immediately you will now be required to provide proof of residency at the gate prior to admittance.
